# Youth profile in Macedonia

#### Numbers:

480.828 youth out of 2.022.547 citizens of Macedonia 1/4 of population (age - 15 – 29 years)

# Youth profile in Macedonia


#### General position in society

25% of high-school students believe they have minimal conditions in the communities they live in. 25% are self-declared socially excluded citizens.

45% of high-school students see themselves out of the country in 10 years from now.

Economy and lack of job availability are the biggest problem according to high-school students.













# Youth profile in Macedonia

#### **Employment:**

56.3% of youth are **inactive**, not working or looking for work. Out of them 73% are inactive due to studies, and others due to household responsibilities.

43.7% are active, out of them 41.8% are employed.

**58.2%** of active youth are **unemployed**.











## Key issues

#### **WEAK YOUTH POLICIES**

National Youth Strategy (2005 - 2015)

– lack of care for implementation

Local Youth Councils in several municipalities – Does the youth know of them?

There is no umbrella organization on a state level – National Youth Parliament?

Macedonia does not have a representative in the European Youth Forum?

Agency of Youth and Sport or Agency of Sport and possibly youth?











### Key problems

70.3% of high-school students do not know if there is an union in their school.

12.8% replied that there is, but they don't know who their class representative is, and only 4% were able to list the name of the representative

81.3% have never participated in the election of a high-school union.

Draft-Law on Youth submitted to the Assembly of Macedonia by the Ministry of Justice without consultation of youth or any youth structure in the country
